Green Bay can be reached via Route 390 in the west or Route 380 in the east — either way you choose, you'll find activities as varied as they are plentiful: hiking, art, and angling are just some of the most popular pursuits in this phenomenal piece of the province. Known for its icebergs and whales, you can explore Green Bay by land or sea. The whale pavilions of King's Point and Triton are great places to learn more about the majestic beasts you will find in these waters. The inland forest is just as beautiful as the surrounding seascapes, where many of the iconic trails will take you past waterfalls, ponds, and rivers. This is also a great area to explore the backcountry, either by ATV or to land the perfect salmon. Green Bay makes for a great winter destination, offering miles of terrain for snowmobiling.

Green Bay

The Dorset Trail, also known as Route 410, brings you to the westernmost reaches of Central Newfoundland, weaving through wilderness and adventure. Indigenous peoples have called this land home for thousands of years, as evidenced by Fleur De Lys' extraordinary soapstone quarry — an active archaeological site left by the Dorset people. The French settlement followed, its history of the peninsula is preserved in the town names, while the English settlers gave rise to the Newfoundland culture that now fills these towns. You'll encounter Baie Verte and its rich mining history, while in La Scie the local museum and tearoom will serve you traditional cuisine. Off the beaten path, this region is filled with coastal trails — and backcountry hiking for the more adventurous. This peninsula invites guests year round to explore its backroads, coves, and trails.
