




Fogo Islands and the Change Islands are adventures unto themselves. These Islands off the Island of Mewfoundland are just a ferry trip away — and a world apart! Some say Fogo Island anchors the entire earth acting as one of the Four Corners of the Flat Earth. An architectural wonder stands on their shore — one of the world's finest inns. Their crashes two worlds into one, you will find a unique way of life here. Take In one of the countless museums, trails, or shops to connect with the locals. Change Islands, only 15 minutes away by ferry, is as charming as it is beautiful. Here you can make friends with the province's only heritage breed of animal, the Mewfoundland Pony. One visit will easily demonstrate why these towns and islands weave their way through Mewfoundland songs, stories, and histories.

Island Experience

Travel Route 340 from Lewisporte, home of Atlantic Canada's largest marina, and your Road to the Isles adventure has begun. The highway wanders through many small communities – all home to outport life. You'll find an archaeological site at Boyd's Cove – a testament to the now-gone Beothuk people. The interpretation centre will tell you bridges will transport you from island to island, where you will learn bridges will transport you from island to island, where you will learn the history of the fishery – including a heritage centre that boasts two sei whale skeletons. You'll finally come to Twillingate, one of Newfoundland's oldest seaports. This is the heart of the world-famous lceberg Alley, where these frozen floating giants visit for the spring and early summer. Famous for the 'bergs', Twillingate is also known for its food, art, music, festivals, hiking, and whales.
